MOBILE LOCKER UNITS

AT&T Stadium will be utilizing mobile lockers to provide secure, convenient storage options for guests who have bags that do not comply with the stadium bag policy. These storage areas are located within AT&T Stadium Parking Lot 5. Locker rental fee is \$10.00 and all transactions are cashless.

POSTEVENT RIDESHARE PICK-UP

The Taxi Queue Lane, outside the West end of the Miller Lite West Plaza will be the rideshare pick-up location for every event taking place at AT&T Stadium in 2020.



To limit the number of touchpoints between staff and fans on game day, all food, beverage, parking and retail is now a cashless experience. Major credit and debit cards, as well as mobile pay will be accepted throughout AT&T Stadium.

ADA/ ACCESSIBILITY

AT&T Stadium is committed to serving guests with disabilities. Our facilities are fully accessible and we provide a wide range of services and amenities for guests with special needs. Guests can receive more information by visiting one of our Guest Services Centers located on the concourse behind Sections 219, 244, 420 and 451. PROHIBITED ITEMS

Bags, purses, outside alcohol, food items*, bottles, cans and beverage containers of any kind*, coolers*, weapons of any kind, laser pointers, footballs, signs or flags on sticks, noisemakers, tripods, monopods and cameras with lens larger than 3" (detachable or non-detachable), video cameras, chairs, stools or other seating devices. *Exceptions will be made for Guests with special medical needs.

SECURITY SCREENING

All guests entering AT&T Stadium are subject to a physical security screening of their person and accompanying items. The physical screening consists of a walkthrough metal detector sweep. Please remove cell phones or larger metal objects prior to screening. Guests who wish not to be screened by metal detector may elect a physical pat-down screening as an alternative. All other articles will be visually inspected. Items in sealed/wrapped boxes must be opened for inspection.

CODE OF CONDUCT

AT&T Stadium Management is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our guests. Our staff will proactively support an environment free from the following behaviors: Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures, intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption, fighting, taunting or threatening remarks or gestures, sitting in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat, displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting, obscene or indecent clothing, any disruption to the progress of the event by the quest's actions.

AT&T STADIUM BAG POLICY IN EFFECT

The Revised AT&T Stadium Bag Policy is in effect for this game. AT&T Stadium instituted the National Football League's policy that limits the size and types of bags entering AT&T Stadium on event days. The policy is a league-wide initiative intended to enhance public safety for events at NFL stadiums across the country. The NFL strongly encourages fans to not bring any type of bags to the venue. However, should bags be needed, approved items include:

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC totes that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Clear one-gallon re-sealable storage bags
- Small clutch purses/bags approximately the size of a hand not to exceed 4.5" x 6.5" in size - with or without a handle or strap

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, seat cushions, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size. TAILGATING POLICIES

- TALLATING POLICIES

 Talligating in defined as the placement of any items on the general (the neiclose), but it not limited to, tests, chairs, colors, greated (the neiclose), but in not limited to, tests, chairs, colors, and the property of the neiclose of designated talligating parking bits. Early which immut have valid parking permit.

 Talligating so only permitted in the great series of Let 5, Let 9. Versions must be valid parking permit.
 Versions which which are provided in the property of Let 5, Let 9. Versions must be provided in Billitatable the Whiteloos may only occupy one grass parking passe and cannot extend more than 18 inches into the provided visibility.

 Talligating must be continued by the area adjoined to the end of 121 to 991 from the road of the provided visibility.

 Any grass area beyond the designated taligating appeace are considered common ground and may be veried by other greats the State of 121 to 991 from the parking bits.

 Safewarks, rands, and didne also must always remain clear Disposer of train the appropriate receiptable located throughout the pushing bits.

 Cooks must be disposed of in the designated coal containation of the greats, parking areas, under or around vehicles.

 All greats must follow the directions and naturations provided by and disposed passes contained and passes contained and carefores in the passes, parking areas, present or around vehicles.
