SHOWTIME PPV & PBC: SPENCE JR. VS UGAS

Unbeaten WBC and IBF Welterweight World Champion Errol "The Truth" Spence Jr. and WBA Welterweight World Champion Yordenis Ugas will square off in a welterweight championship unification showdown on Saturday, April 16th from AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas headlining a Premier Boxing Champions event. Spence-Ugas pits two of the best welterweight champions in the sport in a high-stakes unification match. Both men are coming off impressive victories over elite welterweights at the top class of the division. Spence defeated former champions Danny Garcia and Shawn Porter in his last two fights, while Ugas scored a thrilling upset victory over future Hall of Famer Manny Pacquiao.

POST-EVENT RIDESHARE PICK-UP

The West end of the AT&T Stadium Parking Lot 15 will be the rideshare pick-up location for Unified World Welterweight Championship: Showtime PPV & PBC: Spence Jr. vs Ugas.



To limit the number of touchpoints between staff and fans on game day, all food, beverage, parking and retail is now a cashless experience. Major credit and debit cards, as well as mobile pay will be accepted throughout AT&T Stadium.

ADA/ ACCESSIBILITY

AT&T Stadium is committed to serving guests with disabilities. Our facilities are fully accessible, and we provide a wide range of services and amenities for guests with special needs. Guests can receive more information by visiting one of our Guest Services Centers located on the concourse behind Sections 219, 244, 420 and 451. PROHIBITED ITEMS

Bags, purses, outside alcohol, food items*, bottles, cans and beverage containers of any kind*, coolers*, weapons of any kind, laser pointers, footballs, signs or flags on sticks, noisemakers, tripods, monopods and cameras with lens larger than 3" (detachable or non-detachable), video cameras, chairs, stools or other seating devices.

*Exceptions will be made for guests with special medical needs.

SECURITY SCREENING

All guests entering AT&T Stadium are subject to a physical security screening of their person and accompanying items. The physical screening consists of a walkthrough metal detector sweep. Please remove cell phones or larger metal objects prior to screening. Guests who wish not to be screened by metal detector may elect a physical pat-down screening as an alternative. All other articles will be visually inspected. Items in sealed/wrapped boxes must be opened for inspection.

CODE OF CONDUCT

AT&T Stadium Management is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our guests. Our staff will proactively support an environment free from the following behaviors: Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures, intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption, fighting, taunting or threatening remarks or gestures, sitting in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat, displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting, obscene or indecent clothing, any disruption to the progress of the event by the guest's actions.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

To limit the number of touchpoints, all food and beverage, parking and retail transactions will be cashless.


AT&T STADIUM BAG POLICY IN EFFECT

The AT&T Stadium Bag Policy is in effect for this event. AT&T Stadium instituted the National Football League's policy that limits the size and types of bags entering AT&T Stadium on event days. The policy is a league-wide initiative intended to enhance public safety for events at NFL stadiums across the country. The NFL strongly encourages fans to not bring any type of bags to the venue. However, should bags be needed, approved items include:

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC totes that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Clear one-gallon re-sealable storage bags
- Small clutch purses/bags approximately the size of a hand – not to exceed 4.5" x 6.5" in size – with or without a handle or strap

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, seat cushions, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size. AT&T STADIUM TAILGATING GUIDELINES

All guests wishing to tailgate must observe the following guidelines. These guidelines have been developed to provide a fair, reasonable, and safe tailgating experience of guests. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the loss of tailgating and parking privileges and ejection from the parking lot.

TAILGATING POLICIES

- Tailgating is defined as the placement of any items on the vehicle, including, but is not limited to, tents, chairs, grills, and games.
- Tailgating is only permitted in the grass areas on the perimeter of designated tailgating parking lots. Each vehicle must have a vehicle permit.
- Tailgating is prohibited in (lot 3, portions of Lot 5, Lot 8 & Lot 9).
- Vehicles must be parked as illustrated here. Vehicles may only park in the designated tailgating areas and cannot extend more than 18 inches into the paved drive aisle.
- Tailgating must be confined to the area adjacent to the end of the designated tailgating vehicle parking space (maximum of 12' x 24' per vehicle).
- Any grass areas beyond the designated tailgating spaces are considered common ground and may be used by other guests for tailgating or picnicking activities.
- Vehicles must remain in the parking space and must always remain clear.
- Dispose of trash in the appropriate receptacles located throughout the parking lots.
- Guests must remain in the designated road containers located throughout the parking lots. Do not climb coils or stone stoves on the grass, parking areas, under or around vehicles.
- All guests must follow the direction and instructions provided by stadium personnel (parking staff, security, police, etc.).


TAILGATING PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Deep fryers or any oil-based cooking or frying equipment.
- Alcohol of any kind (candles & gas cooking permitted).
- Barbecuing or grilling.
- Bicycles.
- Blowing, camping, or soliciting/distributing of any kind.
- Advertising or promoting any third-party products (including but not limited to political signs).
- Sale of food, beverage, and/or merchandise.
- Saving parking or tailgating spaces for others.
- Fireworks, firearms, and/or weapons of any kind.
- Use of Unmanned and Remote Controlled Aircraft Systems.

THE USE OF AMPLIFIED SOUND SYSTEMS IS PROHIBITED IN ALL ATT&T STADIUM PARKING LOTS

To provide a fair, reasonable, and safe tailgating experience, the use of amplified sound systems or the use of any device that creates a disturbance or noise that is inappropriate in musical terms is strictly prohibited.

Failure to comply with this restriction will result in the eviction from the parking lot and revocation of parking privileges.
