To limit the number of touchpoints between staff and fans on game day, all food, beverage, parking and retail is now a cashless experience. Major credit and debit cards, as well as mobile pay will be accepted throughout AT&T Stadium.

ADA/ ACCESSIBILITY

AT&T Stadium is committed to serving guests with disabilities. Our facilities are fully accessible, and we provide a wide range of services and amenities for guests with special needs. Guests can receive more information by visiting one of our Guest Services Centers located on the concourse behind Sections 219, 244, 420 and 451. Animals are not permitted in AT&T Stadium with the exception of service animals and service animals in training. For more information, please contact Guest Services at (817) 892-4161.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Bags, purses, outside alcohol, food items*, bottles, cans and beverage containers of any kind*, coolers*, weapons of any kind, laser pointers, footballs, signs or flags on sticks, noisemakers, tripods, monopods and cameras with lens larger than 3" (detachable or non-detachable), video cameras, chairs, stools or other seating devices. *Exceptions will be made for guests with special medical needs.

SECURITY SCREENING

All guests entering AT&T Stadium are subject to a physical security screening of their person and accompanying items. The physical screening consists of a walkthrough metal detector sweep. Please remove cell phones or larger metal objects prior to screening. Guests who wish not to be screened by metal detector may elect a physical pat-down screening as an alternative. All other articles will be visually inspected. Items in sealed/wrapped boxes must be opened for inspection.

CODE OF CONDUCT

AT&T Stadium Management is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our guests. Our staff will proactively support an environment free from the following behaviors: Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures, intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption, fighting, taunting or threatening remarks or gestures, sitting in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat, displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting, obscene or indecent clothing, any disruption to the progress of the event by the guest's actions.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. PROTECTING THE TEAM

Non-vaccinated fans are encouraged to wear masks while not actively eating or drinking while inside AT&T Stadium.

CASHLESS TRANSACTIONS

To limit the number of touchpoints, all food and beverage, parking and retail transactions will be cashless.

AT&T STADIUM BAG POLICY IN EFFECT

The AT&T Stadium Bag Policy is in effect for this event. AT&T Stadium instituted the National Football League's policy that limits the size and types of bags entering AT&T Stadium on event days. The policy is a league-wide initiative intended to enhance public safety for events at NFL stadiums across the country. The NFL strongly encourages fans to not bring any type of bags to the venue. However, should bags be needed, approved items include:

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC totes that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Clear one-gallon re-sealable storage bags
- Small clutch purses/bags approximately the size of a hand – not to exceed 4.5" x 6.5" in size – with or without a handle or strap

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, seat cushions, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size. TAILGATING GUIDELINES

All guests wishing to tailgate must observe the following guidelines. These guidelines have been developed to provide a fair, reasonable, and safe tailgating experience of guests. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the loss of tailgating and parking privileges and ejection from the parking lot.

TAILGATING POLICIES

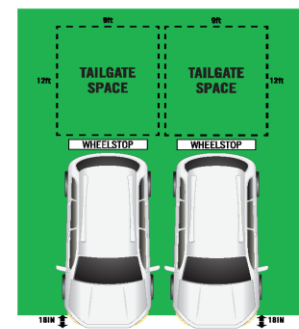
- Tailgating is defined as the placement of any items on the ground (this includes, but is not limited to, seats, chairs, coolers, grills, and games).
- Tailgating is only permitted in the grass areas on the perimeter of designated tailgating parking lots. Each vehicle must have a valid parking permit.
- Tailgating is prohibited in Lot 3, portions of Lot 4, Lot 9 & Lot 9.
- Vehicles must be parked as illustrated here. Vehicles may only occupy one grass parking space and cannot extend more than 18 inches into the paved drive aisle.
- Tailgating must be confined to the area adjacent to the end of the designated tailgating vehicle parking space (maximum of 12ft by 8ft from the rear of the parked vehicle).
- Any grass areas beyond the designated tailgating spaces are considered common ground and may be used by other guests for tailgating or picnicking activities.
- Sidewalks, roads, and drive aisles must always remain clear.
- Disposal of trash in the appropriate receptacles located throughout the parking lots.
- Coals must be disposed of in the designated metal containers located throughout the parking lots. Do not dump coals or stove stoves on the grass, parking areas, under or around vehicles.
- All guests must follow the direction and instructions provided by stadium personnel (parking staff, security, police, etc.).

TAILGATING PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Deep fryers or any oil-based cooking or frying.
- Open flame fires of any kind (charcoal & gas cooking permitted).
- Disorderly conduct.
- Profanity, cursing, or profanity/obscenity of any kind.
- Advertising or promoting any third-party products (including but not limited to food and beverage products).
- Sale of food, beverage, and/or merchandise.
- Sawing parking or tailgating spaces for others.
- Fireworks, firearms, and/or weapons of any kind.
- Use of Unmanned and Remote Controlled Aircraft Systems.

THE USE OF AMPLIFIED SOUND SYSTEMS IS PROHIBITED IN ALL AT&T STADIUM PARKING LOTS.

To provide a fair, reasonable, and safe tailgating experience, the use of amplified sound systems or the use of radios/audio devices at loud levels or that include inappropriate musical lyrics is strictly prohibited. Failure to comply with this restriction will result in the ejection from the parking lot and revocation of parking privileges.



TAILGATING IS NOT PERMITTED ON SIDEWALKS, ROADS OR DRIVE AISLES.
